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This is the Environmental Policy of *Rhino Engineering Group Limited (REGL)* and is applicable to all subsidiary companies (Rhino Systems Limited (RSL), Rhino Site Systems Limited (RSSL), and Rhino HySafe Limited).

Policy and Commitment

REGL recognises that its operations impact upon the environment. Because of this, it is our aim and objective to continually assess the environmental implications of our activities and commit to continuous improvement. We seek the co-operation of all our customers, sub-contractors, suppliers and all our employees, with recognition of compliance with relevant environmental legislation as a minimum level of performance.

To achieve this objective, the company will:

- Work within the framework of existing and future environmental legislation in the countries and regions in which we operate.
- Maintain ISO 14001 Certification.
- Work towards the objective of becoming carbon neutral
- Seek to prevent environmental damage and reduce environmental hazards.
- Seek to review and generate corrective and preventative actions with the aim of continually improving our environmental impact.
- Reduce pollution, emissions, waste and consumption of energy and supplies.
- Liaise with the local community.
- Expect similar environmental standards from all suppliers and sub-contractors.

As part of the overall objective, the company will:

- Minimise the nuisance caused by noise, dust and debris.
- Store and use oils and chemicals in such a way that the possibility of ground contamination is minimised.
- Minimise the use of all raw materials, energy and supplies.
- Minimise waste and, where possible, segregate and recycle waste product and ensure that all waste is disposed of in a manner which complies with current and future legislation.
- Encourage all suppliers and sub-contractors to adopt similar environmental principals, philosophers and controls.
- Commit to the provision of adequate financial & physical resources.

The responsibility for the implementation of this policy remains with the Directors.

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Group Managing Director.
